## Configuring Postfix to use the Fido Anti Spam Cloud Smart Host Relay

Postfix

### **Routing all outgoing mails via the outgoing smarthost:**

You should edit **/etc/postfix/main.cf** and make sure there is a line:

```
relayhost = smtp.fido.net:587
```

### **Routing specific domain destinations via the outgoing smarthost:**

In order to do this, you should add a line to **/etc/postfix/transport**:

```
example.com smtp:[smtp.fido.net]:587
```

After you've made your changes, you should generate a postmap file using:

```
postmap hash:/etc/postfix/transport
```

In order for Postfix to use the transport file, you should add or edit a line in **/etc/postfix/main.cf**:

```
transport_maps = hash:/etc/postfix/transport
```
